PRINCIPAL'S VISIT TO AINTREE PRIMARY SCHOOL

Dr. (Mrs.) Anju Tandon, Principal of Bhavan's Mehta Vidyalaya, was invited to attend 'Women in School Leadership Program: Reciprocal Immersion Program' scheduled in Melbourne, Australia from 12 to 18 May, 2024. This immersion program was a component of the women in school leadership program, launched in India in September 2023. The WISL is a hybrid leadership program incorporating 20 hours online professional learning, a professional immersion in New Delhi, India and a reciprocal immersion program in Melbourne, Australia. It aims to empower school Principals to lead for social change with focus on health and wellbeing. This theme has been selected to align with NEP (2020) pedagogical and curricular restructure, aiming to promote better learning, development and wellbeing. The WISL program is funded by Victorian Department of Education, International Education Division. It is developed and delivered by Asia Education Foundation (AEF) in partnership with the Australia India Institute and Melbourne Graduate School of Education at University of Melbourne.

International Cultural Exchange Program

The students of Mehta Vidyalaya students participated in the following exchange programs:

- In collaboration with Korean Cultural Centre (KCC), India our school started a new batch of Korean Curriculum Classes for the session 2024-25 from 8 April, 2024 with a batch of 45 students each from classes VI & VII for an hour per week.
- In further collaboration with KCC, Taekwondo classes for session 2024-25 started from 1 April with a batch of around 65 students twice a week by Mr. Avinash Kumar Sahni (Black Belt, 3rd dan).
- Integration of online teaching platforms between Mehta Vidyalaya & Aintree Primary School, Victoria helped evaluate the effectiveness and participation in creating a learning environment, specifically focusing on Mathematics for Class VI. As part of Indo-Australian School Interaction, Maths class was taken up by Ms. Naralle, Australian teacher for our school students on 22 April and Mrs. Remya Menon, Maths teacher from Mehta Vidyalaya took class for their students on 29 April. **Math Mindset Survey** was conducted amongst students of both schools and analysis of the same was done.
- The Indo-Taiwan Cultural Exchange Programme saw students from Mehta Vidyalaya, Delhi, and Sijhou School, Taiwan, engaging in an online session on 25 April, 2024 showcasing traditional Indian recipes. Principal, Dr. Anju Tandon and Vice-Principal, Mrs. Jagriti Sharma also participated in this workshop of Indian cuisines.

The visit was a meaningful exchange of ideas on the different dimensions of learning, teaching methods and curriculum development as well as case study projects between Aintree Elementary School Melbourne, Australia and Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan's Mehta Vidyalaya New Delhi, India.

- The Indo-Korean Cultural Exchange Programme saw students from Mehta Vidyalaya, Delhi, and EunPyung High School, South Korea, engaging in an interactive online session on 11 July, 2024. A brief introduction about two schools was followed by student sharing about their interests, likes, etc understanding each other's cultures.
- Under GIRLOSOPHY project on 24 July, 2024, the girl students of Bhavan's Mehta Vidyalaya and Aintree Elementary School in Victoria, Australia interacted and communicated one on one and learnt about each other's culture.



NATIONAL INTEGRATION CAMP

Lunar & Planetary Observation and Capturing the night sky



The Astronomy Club of the school conducted its fourth hands-on workshop on the theme 'Lunar & Planetary Observation and Capturing the night sky' for the students of classes V to IX on 23rd February '24. During the workshop students were given details about the constellations seen in the night sky, phases of the Moon, planets etc. They learnt to use DSLR camera along with a tripod stand for night photography; captured the night sky and saw the Moon, its craters, planet Jupiter and its satellites, star Sirius, Pleiades (known as seven sisters) and Orion Nebula using telescope in the school playground. Through this fascinating activity, the students got an opportunity to watch the night sky closely.

Staff Development Programme

Mehta Vidyalaya, New Delhi organised Capacity Building Programme from 20th May 2024 to 28th May 2024 for the teaching staff members. These workshops were conducted by various field experts and in-house teachers to educate and inform the staff members about various domains related to education.

The series of workshops were quite impactful as they introduced various effective teaching techniques making the teaching learning process more interesting and engaging for learners.
