- Any child who is suffering from respiratory issues, influenza, cold, cough, fever or any other unexplained illness should refrain from attending the school with due intimation to the class teacher.
- Exam/test if any will be rescheduled accordingly depending upon the class he/she is in.
- The school has uploaded NDMC/Ministry of Health & family Welfare advisory of precautionary measures on school website as well as snap home work app. Please go through it and follow guidelines.
- Avoid going to public/crowded places unless it is an emergency.
- Clean hands frequently with soap and water and alcohol based hand rub.
- Send a small bottle of sanitizer in school bag for personal use of your ward.
- Drink plenty of water/liquids and eat nutritious food.
- Must consult a doctor in case of suspected influenza like illness and segregate the person inflected with it.


