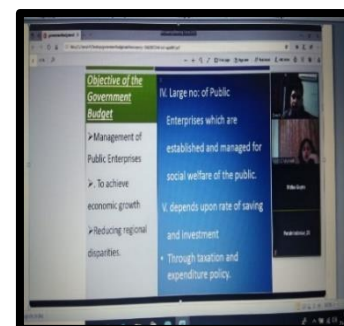
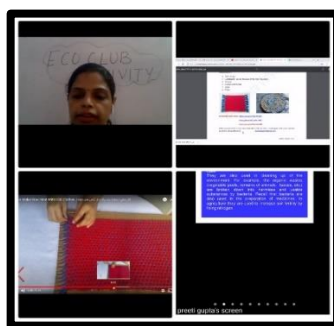
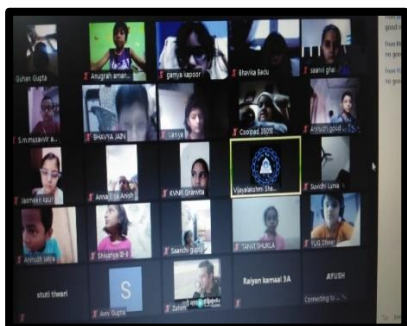
ONLINE RESULT DECLARATION

- The teachers prepared the result online and generated report cards.
- The report cards were downloaded and posted to the parents online on 27th March'2020.
- Queries related to result were taken on phone calls.
- Class XI streams were allotted on the basis of Pre Board 1 and 2 result.
- Examination circulars were uploaded on school website and Snap Homework application.

ONLINE CLASSES (NURSERY TO XII)

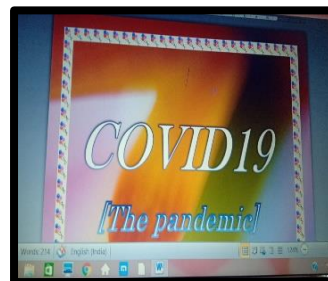
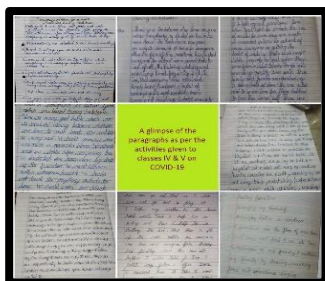
- Timetable was prepared for online classes from 16th March to 14th May'2020.
- Class WhatsApp groups were created by the teachers as a platform for teaching learning process and getting connected directly with the students and parents.
- E-classes for the students were conducted using Skype, Zoom and WhatsApp applications.
- Audio instructions to carry out the activities and concepts to be learnt were shared through WhatsApp groups. Along with learning assignments, rhymes and activities were recorded by the teachers in their own voice.
- Activities were planned and included in the learning assignments with the objective of promoting learning by doing.
- Experiential learning was provided through Art & Craft activities and worksheets, games, rhymes, stories, yoga as has been emphasized in the new Pre-School Curriculum.
- The work done by the kids were shared by the parents through pictures and videos.
- Parents were counselled on their queries pertaining to the learning material by the teachers.
- E-learning content in the form of tutorials, assignments, worksheets, books, notes, presentations, digital question banks, YouTube links, audios, videos, animations was shared with students on Class WhatsApp groups, Snap Homework Application and through Google drive links.
- General Knowledge Classes for III to V were also conducted on Zoom and WhatsApp.
- Audio recordings of the Zoom sessions were created and shared through WhatsApp class groups.
- The students were given access to the content and online courses provided by ExtraMarks, Avishkaar, Diksha by CBSE, Byju's, E-pathshala learning applications.
- Warm up exercises connecting lessons to real-life situations (COVID-19) were taken up under experiential learning.
- Interactive sessions through quiz and worksheets to gauge students' comprehension level were also held.
- Letters and Circulars were posted and uploaded on the Snap Homework application and school website respectively.
- Daily follow up was done of the work done by the students.

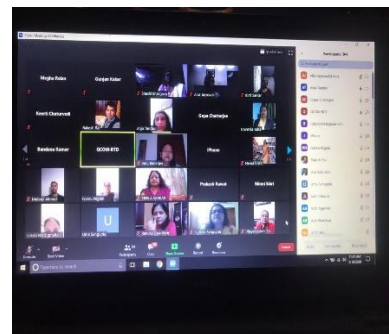
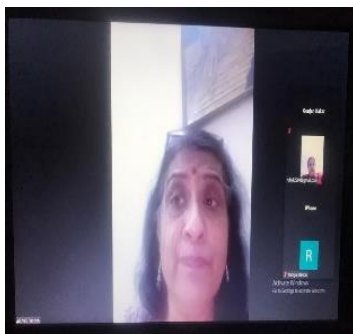
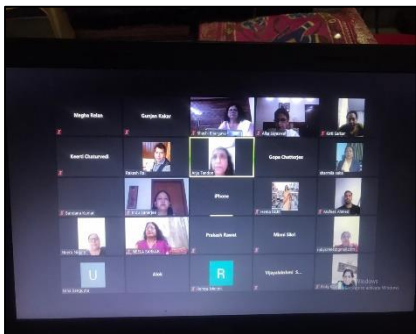
ASSESSMENTS & HOLIDAY HOME WORK

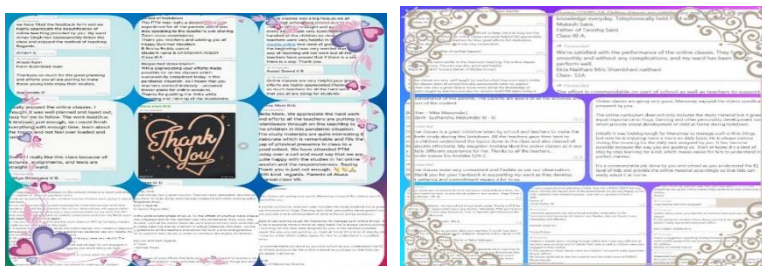
YOUTUBE CHANNEL

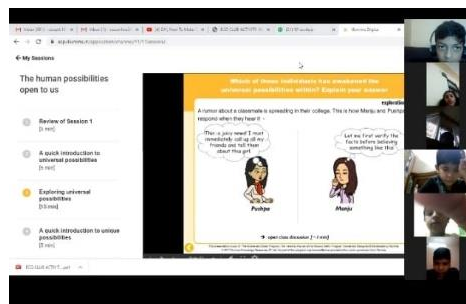
EARTH DAY CELEBRATIONS

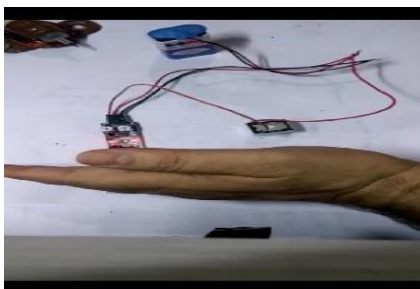
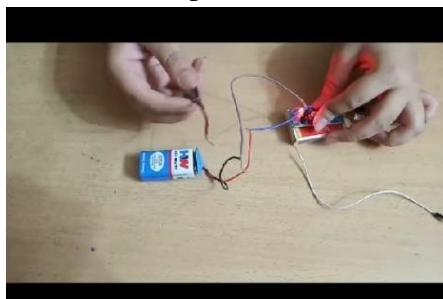
AWAKENED CITIZEN PROGRAMME (ACP)

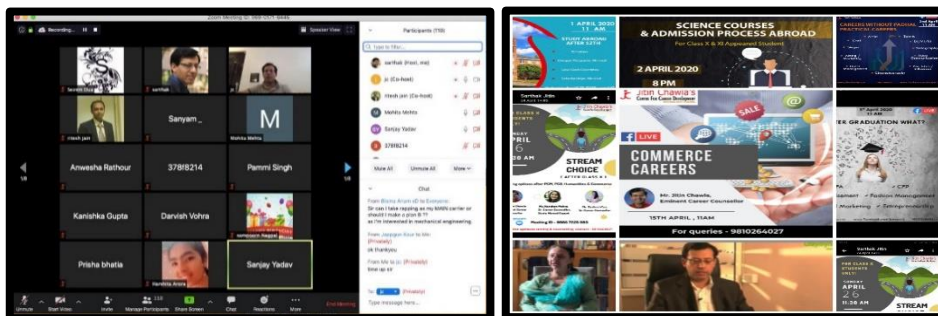

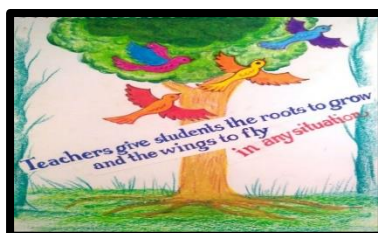
CBSE PROJECT-VIDYADAAN

छू लें आसमां ONLINE BVB -Video by teachers

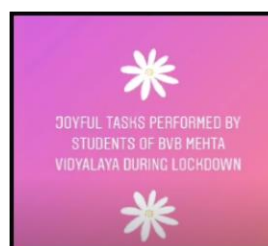

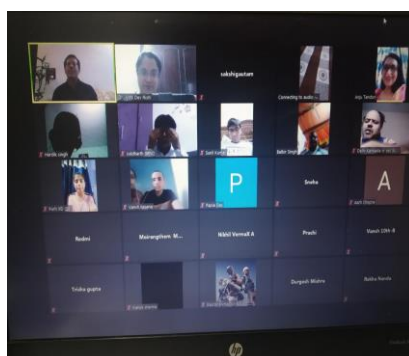
CBSE PROJECT: HUBS OF LEARNING
